OBJECTIVE

 It is important to keep tight control on the use of chemicals in order to reduce departmental operating expenses, ensure correct use and reduce abuse.

STATEMENT OF POLICY & PROCEDURE

- 1. The following actions will ensure adequate controls are in place to control the use of cleaning chemicals:
 - a. Issue Room Attendants with their cleaning chemicals daily and ensure return before going off duty.
 - b. Do not permit storage of cleaning chemicals daily and ensure return before going off duty.
 - c. Label containers according to Room Attendants section
 - d. Avoid the purchase of aerosol containers.
 - e. Train all employees in the correct use of all cleaning chemicals.
 - f. Buy in walk whenever consumption warrants.
 - g. Ensure chemicals are diluted according to manufacturer's instructions.
 - h. Never use a solution any stronger than necessary for satisfactory result.
 - i. Constantly research the market for new, more efficient, less expensive products.
 - j. Keep the number of cleaning chemicals used to the bare minimum necessary.
 - k. Never permit employees to bring their own cleaning chemicals.
 - I. Review consumption monthly.

<u>Note</u>:

• For reason of safety never mix or permit the mixing of different chemicals. Always label chemical containers with the content. Get rid of all unlabelled chemicals.

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
