The Story of Johnnie Walker

John Walker's remarkable story began in 1820 when he was only 15 years old, and already the proprietor of a small grocery store in Kilmarnock, in the south west of Scotland. He was set up in this business following the death of his father who was a farmer. In his small shop, John already blended tea leaves to taste for his customers. He decided to apply those skills to the blending of single malt whiskies, which were becoming increasingly popular and diverse. When John Walker died in 1857, his legacy passed to his son Alexander, who shared his father's zeal and talent for blending, and

He was renowned for his organizational skills and it was mainly due to these that the British intelligence system ceased to be effective in Ireland. The Treaty, which was signed after months of negotiations, gave Ireland a limited amount of freedom, and ultimately led to civil war between those who opposed the treaty and those who wanted peace.

Murphy's Irish Stout is no more
fattening or calorific than any
other beer of similar alcoholic
strength. The beer has no fat,
however it does contain protein,
sugar, carbohydrates and
alcohol. The alcohol accounts for
65-75% of the calorific content
irrespective of the beer in
question. Per pint, Murphy's Irish
Stout has 210 calories;
as a reference, one pint of
semi-skimmed milk has 260
calories and one pint of orange
juice has 220 calories.



The Big Fellow

Michael Collins nicknamed *The Big Fellow* was born at Woodfield, County Cork in 1890.

From an early age he was actively involved in several organizations. He spent nine years living and working in England before returning to Ireland to take part in the Easter Rising of 1916.

For his part in this rebellion he spent several months in prison in Wales. On his release he worked vigorously to achieve independence for his homeland.

Collins supported the treaty as he did not want a resumption of the war with Britain. However, this led him, as commander of the new Free State's army, into conflict with former friends and comrades. Throughout the civil war he worked tirelessly to find a solution to bring peace to the country for which he had fought so hard. It was while attempting to negotiate this peace with his opponents in County Cork on 22nd Aug. 1922 that he was killed in an ambush.

Michael Collins was only 31 when he died and the story of his death at the hands of his former comrades is made even more ironic, when one considers that it was in the role of peacemaker that he faced his greatest danger.
