## TOM HUNTER Sunday, May 7th

Tom Hunter, is a blues pianist who has played every blues club from Manny's Car Wash in New York to Biscuits-n-Blues in San Francisco. From Buddy Guy's Legends in Chicago to The Zoo in Lincoln, Nebraska. A well-traveled and experienced bluesman, Tom Hunter has played for Ruf, Delmark, and Point Blank Records, including a guest spot with Bill Perry. Tom Hunter was also the touring keys player for international blues great Bernard Allison until he decided to be his own frontman and call the shots himself. Tom Hunter was once a pencil pusher for IBM in New York City with a strong passion for the blues. That passion won over him and he soon found himself without a desk job and hittin' the keys like only he knows in blues halls in the South Carolina Region. Since then, Tom Hunter's talents have taken him around the world and across the country multiple times. He is being courted by several front running blues labels for his upcoming CD, and at his current headquarters at Famous Dave's Ribs N' Blues, where he plays Friday and Saturday for Happy Hour, as well as Sunday's Blues N' Brunch, he is constantly invited onstage for a sit-in with the evening blues heavyweights that roll through every night of the week. Tom Hunter has to be seen and heard to be believed. He is truly one of the greatest blues keyboardists alive today.

## JOE T. COOK & THE LONG SHOTS Tuesday, May 9th

Joe T. Cook has been establishing himself as a strong local blues musician for years, playing his heart out on the harmonica in front of inspired audiences many times every week. We used to have him play here once a week but let him open up his schedule for heavier gigging and an expanded audience. We still get excited every time we get a chance to see the boys play their original, down and dirty blues here at their old stomping grounds! Come see for yourself why we're pleased to say: "We knew him when..."

## POWER OF TEN Thursday, May 11th

Featuring 10 extremely talented stage musicians, Power of Ten takes a multidimensional approach, depending on what artist and song is being performed. Spotting new and original versions of R&B's greatest hits, Power of Ten performs the songs & styles of Sam and Dave, James Brown, Otis Redding, Clarence Carter, Aretha Franklin among others. Their sound has been compared to The Blues Brothers, The Saturday Night Live Show Band, and The Commitments.

This band has a large repertoire of popular cover tunes as well as a few originals. Get ready for some booty shakin' R&B!

## SOUL TIGHT COMMITTEE Friday, May 19th

Formerly known as "Lights Out Committee", this large group of local blues turns our Blues club into a retro '70's dance party every time they play here! Fronted by Deb Brown, this group of high energy musicians, including a full horns section, play a lot of soul and funk covers. Expect to hear some Donna Summer, Otis Redding, Sam Cooke, and other R&B favorites, while we use our already sizeable dancefloor. Soul Tight Committee has played here many times and has always proven that this is where the party is!

## THREE BEERS 'TIL DUBUQUE Friday, May 26th

Normally at Famous Dave's if we say "r&b", we're talkin' about ribs n' blues. Not so this Saturday when Wisconsin's Three Beers 'til Dubuque hits the stage with their soulful set list featuring songs by Tito Puente, James Brown, Kool & the Gang and more.
